**Hosting a playgroup or park day need not be stressful!
Here are a few guidelines for all to remember:**

- For a playgroup at your home, the hostess is responsible for only beverages (coffee, juice, etc.) since she's invested time in cleaning prior to the playgroup. Guests are responsible for bringing snacks. For a park day, the hostess is not responsible for beverages.
- Call the hostess at least a day in advance to RSVP. Hostesses need to plan ahead and may need to limit guests based on space limitations
- All playgroups are open to all members of the MOMS Club, however, if the number of guests attending is reaching capacity of your home, you may encourage additional callers to host another playgroup and redirect additional callers to that person.
- If there are any changes, Hostesses are responsible for contacting those who had RSVP'd to let them know of the change.
- The hostess should childproof their home for their guests. Guests should be watchful of their children during the playgroup & help "pick up" at the end of a playgroup. Children who are physically or verbally abusive toward other children should be removed from the activity immediately by the parent. If the behavior continues to be a problem the child may be asked not to attend the activity in the future.
- Children who have had any of the following symptoms in the past 24hours should not attend the activity (severe cough, vomiting, sore throat, diarrhea/upset stomach, unexplained spots or rashes, green/yellow mucus from nose, pink eye, fever, lice, any diagnosed infection that has not yet been treated with antibiotics for at least 24hrs)
- Most activities end 2 hours from the start time on the calendar unless otherwise noted. Please respect these time even if you arrive late. Oftentimes, moms have a hard time arriving at the designated start time but it is acceptable to pop in anytime throughout.
